

Virtual Behavioral Expectations

- Join your class google meet a couple minutes early to ensure proper connection.
- Google Meets will serve as your attendance for the period so it's very important you attend.
- Remain available for the entire duration of the period. Instructional times will vary from class-to-class, teacher-to-teacher.
- Have your camera and audio on for attendance. Mute yourself except when talking; this limits the background noise.
- Be an active participant in the meeting and answer questions when called upon.
- Dress appropriately, follow HFCS code of conduct guidelines. This includes shirts and pants/shorts for meets.
- Student's face must be visible to the teacher. In addition, you must have a background or wall behind you during the meet. Please refrain from distracting backgrounds.
- Do not share the google meet link with anyone outside of your class.
- Only use the chat as instructed by your teacher (the content of the chat should be for classroom use only, chats will be saved and monitored)
- Do not record or take pictures of your teacher or anyone else in the meet.
- While in the google meet, try not to be a distraction to the other students attending the class.
- Be present - Avoid multitasking
